Costs & Financial Aid

The estimated cost for the study tour to Turkey is \$1,600. This amount will cover the cost of all transportation within Istanbul, accommodation, meals, and entrance fees to various cultural/historical sites. The cost does not include the round-trip ticket from Washington to Istanbul and any tuition charged by home institutions. Participants will buy their round tickets by themselves. Students may apply for financial aid at their home institutions.
