Seventh annual Ecumenical Essay Contest

Topics for the essay should emphasize one of the following:

- Theory: An academic exploration of the History, Theology, or Dialogues of the Ecumenical Movement, be they multi-ecclesial/denominational or bilateral between two churches or traditions.
- Practice: An aspect of Practical Ecumenism or Spiritual Ecumenism, including local to national efforts or international efforts to expand ecumenical dialogue, shared spiritual practice, and/or education.

Essay should be between **12 and 18 pages** (double spaced), and should be a graduate level paper.

Submissions will be accepted electronically until **April 15, 2014**

Winners will receive a monetary reward, public recognition and online publication
